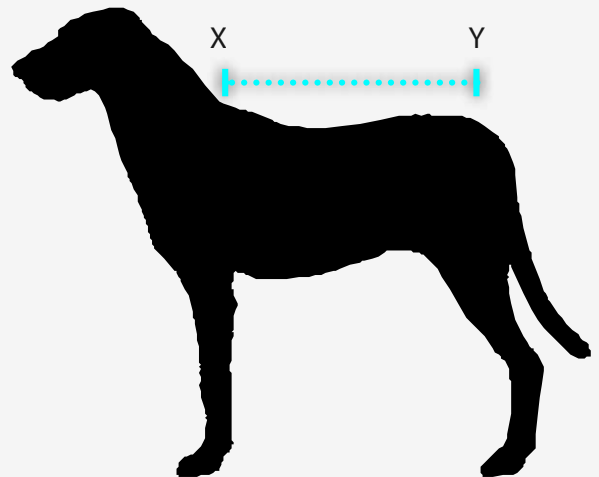
## SIZE GUIDE

### Jumpers and Coats...

To measure the length of your dog for coat or pullover size:

- Take 1 tape measure and 1 dog.
- Measure from the base of the neck (x) to the base of the tail (y) and record the cm measurement. (See diagram)
- Choose a coat or pullover that matches the size that you have recorded.

Please note that as many of our coats and pullovers are handmade the size may vary slightly.



### Collars...

To measure the length of your dog for a collar:

- Take 1 tape measure and 1 dog.
- Place the tape measure around neck where collar naturally sits and allow a little room for comfort. You should be able to easily fit two fingers (flat) between the measuring tape and your dog's neck.

Please note that as many of our collars are handmade sizing may vary slightly.
